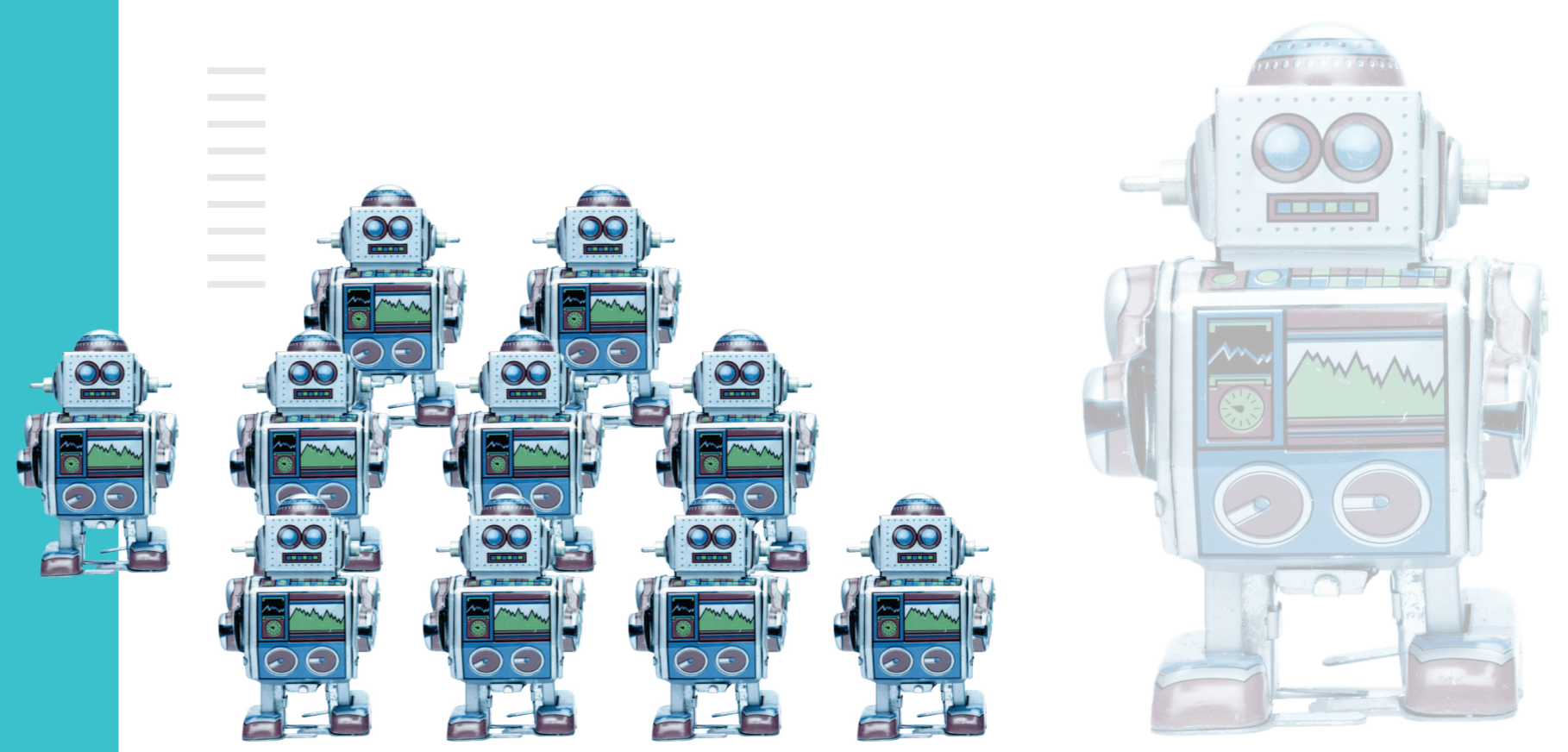

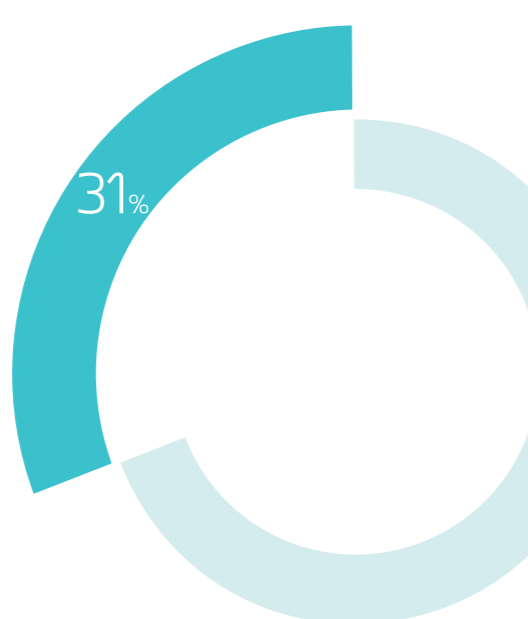
Which Will Define Your 2018 Testing Strategy

Most companies are somewhere between 0% and 30% of automated test coverage



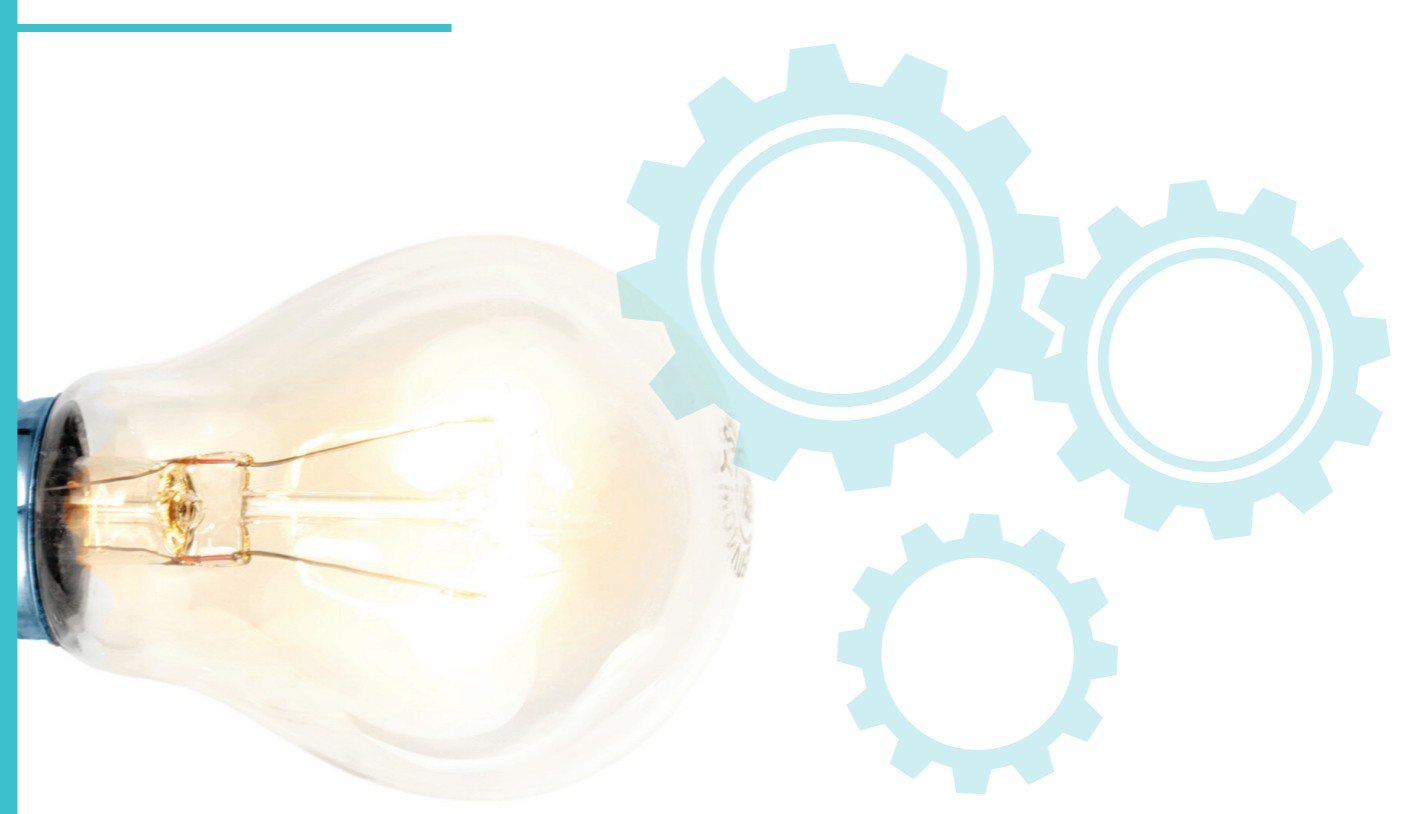
More than 30% always test more than they need to ensure quality.

76% of testers find business process quality more important than time-to-market

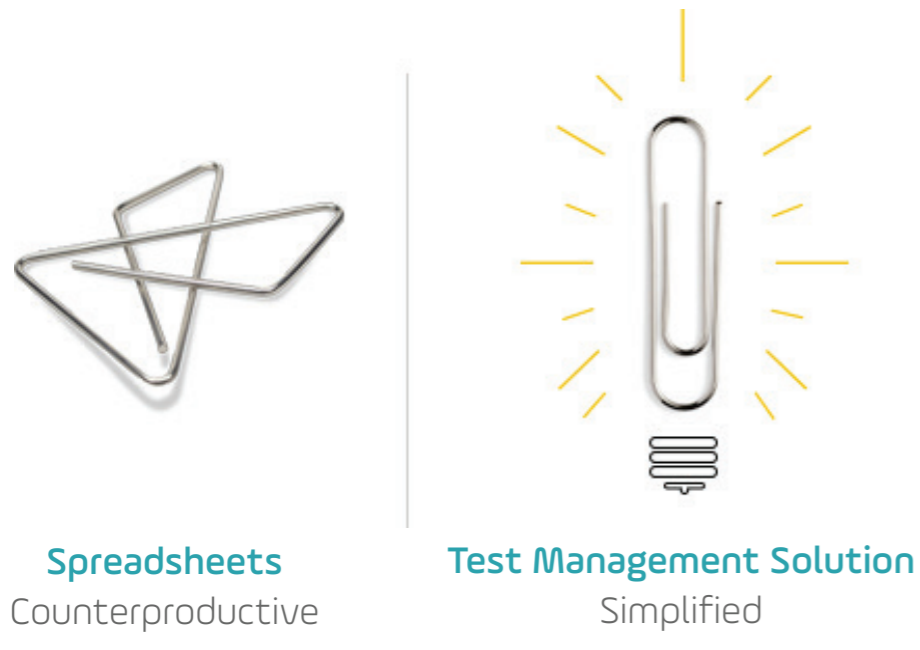
